Women in Leadership

Did you know that for every 1 female leader in the creative and cultural sectors there are 2.5 males? This is just one of the results that will be published in the CLP commissioned research **Women in Leadership**. Carried out by TBR, it has established the baseline of women currently in leadership positions in the creative and cultural industries today. The report will be published in January and will be available to download from the CLP website.

The second round of **International Placements for Creative Entrepreneurs** has now been recruited and will begin in early 2009. In his **article**, Ammo Talwar a participant from round one, shares his placement experiences in South Africa.

The Cultural Leadership Programme has prioritised **Governance** as a core part of its work and commissioned the Clore Leadership Programme to deliver a range of activities, including a repeat series of 12 Board Awaydays which will begin in the New Year. Clore will also be offering a day for New Chairs, three days for New Board Members and six days for Chairs and Chief Executives, all of which will take place from April 2009.
